## Non-Profit Fact-Checking Organizations

Organizations that focus on verifying the accuracy of claims and providing context.



## News Aggregators with Diverse Sources

These curate articles from various sources, allowing you to compare perspectives. Look for aggregators with a reputation for including a variety of viewpoints.



## Established News Sources with High Reporting Standards

News with strong journalistic ethics: Look for publications known for their commitment to factual reporting and evidence-based journalism.



## Media Bias Ratings

Organizations that use proprietary methods to rate and compare media/news sources.



\*Remember, there's no single source you can rely on to be completely unbiased. It's important to be a critical consumer of news and get your information from a variety of reputable sources with different perspectives. By being aware of bias, you can become a more informed consumer of information.
